### District 6 Director & Treasurer Elections at the Regional

This year is an election year for district 6. If you are interested in running for either position and have any questions please contact either April and/or Jason Rasa.

### **According to the By-Laws these are the requirements for a District Director:**

To be eligible a candidate should have been an active voting member for two membership years. They shall have been an active member of the district in which they are running for office for one membership year. A district director's term is 3 years and they shall serve no more than 2 consecutive terms. Other tasks include:

- Shall have primary responsibility for the continuance of activities in the district and the solicitation of membership.
- Shall screen applicants for membership.
- Shall appoint all committee chairpersons in the district.
- Shall oversee local area chapters and their officers in respect to ongoing activities.
- Shall serve as a member of the Board of Directors.
- Shall work for the formation of local chapters.
- All District Directors are limited to activities within the boundaries of their respective districts with respect to membership and dues.
- Shall provide financial reports for the District and Chapters within the District as per the LPA Policy Manual.
- Shall train the district director-elect.

### **According to the By-Laws these are the requirements for a District Treasurer:**

- Keep records of all district financial transactions
- File quarterly financial reports promptly (refer to district director duties)
- Write thank you notes for donations.

### **Mid Year Meeting for LPA officers scheduled in February**

The LPA board approved the proposal for a mid-year meeting to be held at the Newport Beach Marriott Hotel at Fashion Island, Newport Beach, CA. This meeting will take place Friday February 17 – Sunday February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Travel expenses for the Executive Committee members will be taken from their budgets and the District are asked to financially assist their directors. The purpose of the meeting is to have the new LPA board work on strategic planning for the next 3 years.
