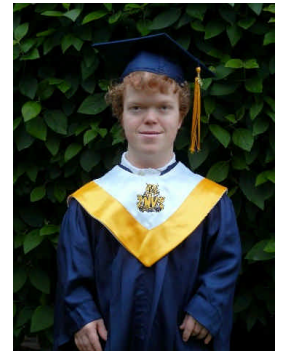


Samyuktha Gumidala

From the North: Take 294 south to I-55 south. Then go to Route 83 (Kingery Road) south to Route 171 Archer Avenue south. Go just passed Cog Hill Country Club golf course to McCarthy Road and make a right on McCarthy Road. Northview Park will be between 5th and 4th street.

From the East: W. 123rd St. is McCarthy Road. On W. 123rd St. go passed LaGrange Rd (96th Avenue) and proceed over S. Archer Avenue (Route 171). 123rd turns in to McCarthy road Northview Park will be between 5th and 4th street.

From the West: Take 355 south to I-55 North (Chicago). First exit is South Lemont Road off of I-55. Take Lemont Road south where it will become Stephen Street and then become State Street. Turn Left onto East Illinois Street then Right onto Stephen Street. Turn Left onto McCarthy Road. Northview Park will be between 4th and 5th street on the left side.

From the South: Take I-55 North (Chicago) to South Lemont Road. Follow directions above From the West.
